Safety Precautions

Before using, always make certain:

- ✓ Care-giver has received appropriate instructions and training.
- ✓ The Instruction Guide has been carefully studied and understood.
- ✓ The individual is secured to the table using the 2 (two) integrated safety belts provided.
- ✓ Do not, at any time, leave anything under the change table

Scope of Application


The Wall Mount Changing Table is a lifting device. Through the use of an electrically powered hand control, which is connected to a 24V actuator, the table is lowered to the height of the wheelchair enabling the caregiver to provide transfer assistance onto the table in a safe manner.

Once on the table, the individual must be secured using the two (2) integrated safety belts. The caregiver can then proceed to raise the table to their ideal working height.

The Wall Mount version of the table comes equipped with (3) three wire baskets which can hold accessories required for changing and cleaning.

With a lifting capacity of 250 lbs., it is suitable for use in schools, clinics, private homes, and other care-giving situations for children.

Specific Features

- The padded top comes complete with two (2) integrated safety belts
- Three (3) wire baskets located under the table top are standard
- Adjustable in height from 21 inches (floor to padded) to 37 inches
- Powered by 110VAC to 24VDC power supply
- Electric hand control can be fastened to front cover with Velcro when not in use
- Front cover is acrylic for easy cleaning

Installation Instruction

For Block Wall

Place MAIN frame against the wall
(See Manufacture Specifications for complete instructions)
Adjust the legs to get frame in level (use a level)
Hold frame against the wall and predrill with 3/8" drill and install "Single Expansion Shields"
Bring the frame back and fasten with 3/8" bolts

Power Supply

Place front cover up close to frame and connect plug from front cover to the power supply box Note: In slot on box

Front Cover

Place front cover over MAIN frame and fasten with $\frac{1}{2}$ " bolt

Operating and Handling Instructions

- Using the hand control the care-giver lowers the table to a height where they can easily and safely transfer individual from wheelchair to padded table top.
- Upon completion of transfer, care-giver must secure individual using the 2 (two) integrated body safety belts provided.
- Once individual is safely secured to change table, care-giver can proceed to raise table to a comfortable working position.

Before using always make certain:

The Instruction Guide has been carefully studied and understood.
Care-giver has received appropriate instruction and training.
Individual is secured to the table with the 2 integrated safety belts.
At any time DO NOT store anything under the table top.
